Findings:

- The Appellant preferred application under section 6(1) of the Right 7. to Information Act on 13/7/2023 seeking information. The application submitted by the Appellant with the 1st Respondent on 13/7/2023 does not seem to be in tune with the provisions under the Right to Information Act. Within the statutory period the 1' Respondent informed the Appellant that information sought for would bar under Section 8 (1) (i) of the Act. I have gone through the nature of the questions put forward by the Appellant in her application to find out whether the disclosure of information relates to personal information. The Appellant wanted to get addresses, transfer certificates, mark lists etc. of the students graduated from Maharajas College, Ernakulam in the year 2000. The information sought for by the Appellant relates to 3rd party. The documents including mark list of the students are personal information and therefore, its disclosure would bar under section 8(1) (j) of the Right to Information Act. The reply of the Respondents is found to be in line with the provisions under the Act. It is not only personal information but unrelated to a public activity or interest. No doubt, giving such information would invasion of privacy of the students. In consideration of such proposition of law on the subject, I have no hesitation to reject the prayer in the appeal. Therefore, I do so. For the reasons above stated, the appeal stands dismissed.
- The Commission disposed of this Appeal Petition as stated above on the 31st day of July, 2024.
